



## FEES AND BILLING

Anna Prinsloo is registered with the South African Society of Physiotherapy (SASP) and the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA) in the capacity of a physiotherapist only. Physiotherapy sessions are claimable from the medical aid schemes.

Anna Prinsloo charges a set rate of R700 for a 50 minute session. Fees for physiotherapy appointments are payable upfront by the client. The client will then be provided with a statement that can be submitted to the medical aid scheme.

PLEASE NOTE: Medical aid providers reimburse the cost of the session according to the treatment codes used. The amount that will be reimbursed for a specific treatment code differs between medical aid schemes. **The treatment codes may vary for each treatment, therefore the amount your medical aid scheme reimburses you may be different for each treatment.** Unfortunately, in my opinion, some of the most popular medical aid schemes are not providing fair compensation for physiotherapists, and are very stringent about the parameters for the use of each treatment code. Anna feels that given her many years of training, ongoing professional development and experience that R700 is a fair fee for a session. **This amount is covered in full by some medical aids, but please be aware that some medical aids will not cover the amount in full.**
